## **FREE EXPUNGEMENT WORKSHOP**

Expungement is the process of going to court to ask a judge to seal a court record. It is important to remember that **an expunged record is NOT destroyed.** The police FBI, immigration officers, and other public officials may still see sealed court files for certain purposes. Usually, people ask for an expungement when they have been denied housing, a job or a professional license because of their criminal background.

**NOTE:** Expungement of housing eviction records is a different type of action.
